What is EurSafe?

The European Society for Agricultural and Food Ethics (EurSafe) is an independent organisation, which provides a network for those who have an interest in the ethical issues involved in agriculture and food supply. The Society is an international, interdisciplinary and cross-cultural organisation, which bridges the line between academia and the world of practice.



Aims

- To encourage international academic research and education on the ethical issues involved in agriculture and food supply.
- To encourage international scientific and public debate on the ethical issues involved in agriculture and food supply.



Conferences

One of the main activities of EurSafe is to organise networking activities such as international conferences and workshops. The Society's premier event, the EurSafe Congress, has proved to be an important European meeting where academics, industry, non-governmental organisations and policy-makers discuss the current 'state of art' in agricultural and food ethics. In addition this event provides a useful platform for all professions who have an interest in the ethical issues involved in agriculture and food supply. Since the society has been established, successful conferences have taken place across Europe. Host cities have included Copenhagen, Florence, Oslo and Vienna.



Network

EurSafe is an international network for those who work or carry out research in the agriculture and food sectors. The forum provides an opportunity for members to interact with partners from different regions and disciplinary backgrounds.

Research

The unique cross-disciplinary nature of EurSafe provides an excellent platform for facilitating and coordinating international and multidisciplinary research collaborations such as those funded through EU programmes.
